<u>Final Regular Weekly Meeting of RY 2017-2018 President</u> with presentation of her annual summary report

President Rtn. Chandralekha Kayastha thanked all the RCP family for the confidence and support given during her presidency. The presidency provided her the opportunity to know the RCP family even more closely. Being the first woman president of the RC Patan has added another achievement to her after being the first woman architect of Nepal. She distributed 'Sweets' to all present in celebration.

President Rtn. Chandralekha Kayastha presented a summary report of her presidency summarized in two categories – 'Service' and 'Fellowship' - a comprehensive report will be made for the Lalitdhara Souvenir issue.

Fellowship: Birthday fellowships, Past Presidents Meetings, Charter Day celebration, family outings to Bhaktapur and Bandipur with a regular club meeting, and joint board meeting – all with spouse participation.

Service: 51 regular meetings, 2 joint meetings, 5 club assemblies, 8 classification talks, 16 guest speakers & 12 board meetings, charter day celebration, KEEA programme, interaction programmes on 'Heart Health', several health camps including one with NRCL, and vocational service award programme. A major achievement was the signing of the 'MOU' with Sarswati Govinda Foundation contributing one million Nepalese Rupees every year to the PEEF programme, which significantly increased the scholarships to needy children given by the RCP.

Club Service Fund was raised from NRs. 14.84 Lakh to 30.38 Lakh. This is more than doubling of the fund through contributions of members, matching by Rtns. Matsyendra L. and Chandralekha Kayastha, and contribution of 10.71 Lakh by late Rtn. Kamalmani Dixit's sons.

RCP has successfully closed four global grants and five global grants are ongoing for the next year. The RCP also got two awards from the District on two closed global grants of this year. Collaboration with the Rotaract Club of Patan and the two Interact Clubs have been excellent. In terms of TRF, the RCP was able to raise US \$4750. Another major achievement was the winning of first prize on 'Rota Quiz' from the District. Additional prize was also received for the 'Club Exhibit' during the District Conference.
