### Summary of Classification Talk of Rtn. Madan R. Tamrakar

Born in 2011 B.S. in Lalitpur near Mangal Bazar area Rtn. Madan Raj Tamrakar had a very interesting childhood always being inquisitive and trying to explore new things.

Rtn. Madan started his professional career with a job at Nepal Bank Ltd, Harisiddhi Brick and Tile Factory Branch in Teller & Day Book Department.

After that, he worked in various other branches and departments of Nepal Bank Ltd. like Lalitpur, Gabahal Branch and Kathmandu Office, New Road, before being promoted to become a second in command at Bagar Branch Kaski, Pokhara, during which posting he talked about swimming across Fewa Lake several times at a time. He was transferred back to the Head Office, New Road, and again to the Kathmandu Office, and lastly at Maisthan Branch, Birgunj as second in command.

Upon getting a job offer from Everest Bank Ltd., he resigned from Nepal Bank Ltd. in 2051 and joined Everest Bank. His first assignment at Everest Bank Ltd. was as the in-charge of the extension counter, New Road, then as second in command at New Road Branch. He then moved on as the in-charge of the extension counter, Kuleswor and then as Branch Manager at Simara, Bara. Thereafter he was transferred to Bhaktapur Branch as Branch Manager, and then to the Head Office in Inspection Department. He again moved to Gwarko Branch, Lalitpur as Branch Manager and lastly in the Head office, Lazimpat in Inception Department before his retirement in 2071.

After his retirement, he visited Australia to see his son's and daughter's families and enjoying stress-free life. Now he is enjoying life as a Rotarian. He expressed his gratitude to Rtns. Mahendra S. Rawal and Jamuna K. Tamrakar for inviting him to be a member of the Rotary Club of Patan.
