#### Joint meeting with the Network of Rotary Clubs of Lalitpur (NRCL) with the participation of the NRCL Chair and members from other clubs

Following the agenda of the RCP's regular meeting, President Rtn. Lalita Thapa handed over the conduct of the meeting of the NRCL to its Chairperson Rtn. Rajani Shrestha. As there will be a separate minute of the NRCL meeting, these are not covered here, but a summary of issues related to the RCP are captured herein.

The NRCL chairperson Rtn. Rajani Shrestha appreciated the RCP for hosting the meeting recalling the RCP as the initiator of the NRCL in 2003 when Rtn. Siba B. Rajbhandary and Rtn. Ganesh R. Shrestha were the RCP's President and Secretary respectively. The NRCL has grown from its original membership of 12 clubs to its current strength of 16 clubs.

Rtn. Rajani Shrestha briefed on the current plans and priorities of the NRCL and requested Rtn. Badan Nyachhyon and Rtn. Dinesh Manandhar to elaborate further.

President Rtn. Lalita Thapa in her part explained the RCP's priorities in its collaboration with the NRCL as (i) Waste Free Lalitpur (ii) Ethics symposium and (iii) Animal welfare for public health. She also requested all the members to register/participate in the upcoming "Walkathon" on Saturday 21 September 2019 in support of the restoration of Bhimsen Temple in Mangal Bazar, Lalitpur as part of its support to the activities of NRCL.

President Elect Rtn. Nirmal K. Pradhanang provided more details on the RCP's plans to work on animal welfare for public health where collaboration with the NRCL would add value.
