- 1. President Rtn. Lalita C. Thapa called the virtual RCP Meeting No. 1712 through 'Zoom' to order with 15 seconds of 'Silent Invocation' for world peace, health, and happiness.
- 2. Guests welcomed by the President: Rotaract Club of Patan IPP Rtr. Peshal Bhattarai and PE Rtn. Kritika Sharma.
- 3. The last meeting minutes were reviewed and adopted.

- Rtn. Bijaya Mallapaty shared the current developments at the Nepal Orthopaedic Hospital (NOH). The Supreme Court has
 cancelled the interim coordination committee of the Nepal Disabled Association (NDA) chaired by the Mayor in favour of the
 elected Chair of the NDA. Since the NDA is still not operational and the NDA Chair is also the Chair of the NOH Board, NOH
 is facing practical difficulties of operation.
- It was suggested to review in the Board RCP's current sister-club relations with other clubs and formalise it.
- President Elect of Rotaract Club of Patan reminded on the invitation to RCP members to join in their 23rd Installation Ceremony and 24th Charter Day being virtually held on 30 June 2020 at 7.00 p.m.

12th Joint Board Meeting of Rotary Year 2019-2020 and 2020-2021 held on 27 June 2020

Secretary Rtn. Mahendra S. Rawal presented the minutes/decisions of the 12th Joint Board meeting, which were endorsed/approved by the 'House'. The virtual Board meeting was conducted via 'Zoom' application on 27 June 2020. Fourteen Board members participated in the meeting.

The meeting was hosted by President Elect Rtn. Nirmal K. Pradhanang. In view of the Covid-19 pandemic, there was no post-board fellowship. Rtn. Nirmal K. Pradhanang pledged to host a fellowship party for the entire RCP members with spouses as early as the situation would permit. On behalf of all Board members, President Lalita C. Thapa gave a special 'Vote of Thanks' to President Rtn. Nirmal K. Pradhanang for his pledge.

The minutes/decisions of the 12th Board meeting are as follows:

- 1. The minutes of the 11th Board Meeting were reviewed.
- 2. Treasurer Rtn. Bharat N. Joshi presented the agenda items related to financial status as follows:
- Membership dues for 2020-2021, due by 30 June 2020, have been received from about half of the members. All the remaining members were requested to settle the dues as well as any outstanding pledges made as soon as possible in July 2020. Possible payment mechanisms (cheque/cash or by electronic transfers) were explained.
- Financial statements with details of income and expenditures of the RCP were presented as of 27 June 2020. Taking note of the comments made by members, Rtn. Bharat N. Joshi confirmed that final statements will reflect the status as of 30 June 2020 taking into account comments made by members and the transactions till 30 June 2020.
- Following preliminary discussions held in the last Board meeting, the proposed budget for 2020-2021 of NRs. 19,48,000 was presented. Following due deliberations, it was approved by the Board. A review will be done after six months to review the impact of Covid-19. This budget does not include the RCP's two Trust Funds (PEEF and KPAD) and Global Grants. It was agreed to have a summary sheet that includes the status of these to have a comprehensive financial picture of the club.
- 3. Board thanked Treasurer Bharat N. Joshi for the comprehensive presentations on all the financial aspects.
- 4. Service Project Chairperson Rtn. Bijaya Mallapaty presented a brief status update on the RCP's services projects club managed programmes and global grants.
- 5. Rtn. Nirmal K. Pradhanang briefed on the status of formation of the RCP's various committees. Following consultation with members, he will present the proposal in the next board meeting. For the Lalitdhara Souvenir committee, Rtn. Mahendra S. Rawal was proposed as its coordinator. Rtn. Jeevan K. Shrestha, current coordinator, and a few other members will be part of the team.
- 6. Rtn. Mahendra S. Rawal shared some 'food for thought' on possible areas of attention/new initiatives in the focus area 'basic education and literacy' in the context of Covid-19 pandemic and its serious impact in public schools. As the RCP has long been very active in this focus area with PEEF, KEEA, WASH global grant and other support projects, it would be opportune to explore what the RCP could do as a matter of priority in the coming year, particularly in facilitating the opening of the schools after the lockdown. It was suggested to review this further including in the PEEF committee.
- 7. Rtn. Siba B. Rajbhandary volunteered to be the host of the next Board meeting at the end of July 2020.
- 8. A 'vote of thanks' was given to the departing members of the Board Rtns. Bishwa B. Sharma, Gabriele Mallapaty and Kiran Thapa for their excellent contributions
