- 7. Rotary News/Information Sharing:
  - President a.i. Kayastha briefed on the District Membership Development Seminar, which had a good participation of 5 members from the RCP. He noted our District's ambitious target of adding 600 new members during this Rotary Year.
  - Mr. Ek B. Bhandari, Headmaster of Mahendra Adarsha High School, Immadol, briefed on the situation of the school appreciating the RCP's support with scholarships and computers and urged for additional support.
  - Rtn. Lalita Thapa updated on the status of 'Souvenir' preparation in detail. She requested all the contributors of articles, advertisements and other information to provide their materials by Tuesday, 19 August 2014.

- It was agreed to have messages of 'best wishes' from all RCP Members in the Souvenir and collect a contribution of NRs. 500 from each member.
- President a.i. Kayastha, Secretary Mallapaty and Coordinator Rtn. Kedar B. Shrestha briefed on the status of preparations for the Charter Day celebration of 29 August. Maximum presence of Members and Spouses was requested from 5.30 p.m. It was also suggested to inform the Secretary, in advance, if members would like to make any special contribution to Rotary during the 'Charter Day' meeting.
- Rtn. Bijaya Mallapaty briefed the 'House' on the finalization of the RCP's Committees following circulation of a draft and taking into account comments/suggestions of all members.
- 8. Secretary Gabriele Mallapaty presented the revised Constitution and By-Laws of the RCP that had been circulated to all Members with all comments/suggestions from members incorporated. The 'House' approved both these documents unanimously.
- 9. Rtn. Bijaya Mallapaty briefed on the District's request in support of the victims of National Calamity due to recent landslides and floods in Nepal. It was agreed to raise a special contribution, in addition to the RCP's regular contributions to the District Disaster Relief Fund already made earlier. The funds thus raised by the RCP will be handed over to the District Governor during the Charter Day celebrations on 29 August 2014 with a request to donate it to the Disaster Management mechanism of the Government of Nepal for this purpose. Members were requested to contribute by Monday, 25 August 2014 for this cause.
- 10. Before the closure of the meeting by the President a.i. with special thanks to everyone for their support, the Secretary announced: contributions to 'Sunshine' Fund: NRs.8,000, attendance: members 25, guests 2, visiting Rotarian 1, and make-up 8.
