 - Rtn. Som Paneru for a very well-organized 'Quarterly Birthday Fellowship' event.

4. Other Contributions:

- As announced during the last 'Quarterly Birthday Fellowship' of the RCP in the presence of President Khruschev Shrestha, Rtn. Siba B. Rajbhandary handed over a cheque of <u>US \$10,000</u> to the President a.i., a contribution to the PEEF from Dr. Prabhu Prabhakar, USA, through Jabina Rajbhandary.
