6. Rotary News/Information:

PDG Rtn. Tirtha M. Sakya briefed on the outcome of the meetings of the District Officials with Rotary

International officials in Sao Paulo related to Earthquake relief in Nepal. The plan is to support 1,000 units of low-cost housing and 140 water/sanitation and other facilities in the affected areas. A separate District Disaster Relief Steering Committee, with 5 members for the time being, was formed with PDG Rtn. Tirtha M. Sakya named as its Chairman. This outfit will have its own separate office and will also work in collaboration with a Trust Fund established in India by Past RI Presidents Kalyan Banarjee, Raja Sabu and others.

- Rtn. Kedar B. Shrestha briefed on the plans to have a simple Charter Day function of the RCP this year on or about 29 August 2015. The District Governor's visit may not coincide with this event as the schedule mentioned is for 16 November 2015.
- Rtn. Gabriele Mallapaty informed and asked to get back with any questions on the release of the RCP's Earthquake Update No. 3, done by e-mail to all members and posting on the RCP's Facebook Page.
