Minutes of Meetings No.1596

- 1. President Rtn. Chandralekha Kayastha called the Meeting No. 1596 to order with 15 seconds of 'Silent Invocation' for World Peace and Happiness.
- 2. Guests welcomed by the President: Rotaract President Rubina Shakya and three Rotaracts from the Rotaract Club of Patan.
- 3. The last meeting minutes were reviewed and adopted.
- 4. 'Happy News' Contributions:
 - Rtn. Jeevan K. Shrestha for being the 'Chief Guest' in the Engineering Campus function.
 - Rtns. Chandralekha and Matsyendra L. Kayastha for a successful hosting of the Board Meeting followed by fellowship (NRs. 2,000).
 - Rtn. Bijaya Mallapaty for the above and for the visit of children (NRs. 500).
 - PDG Rtn. Tirtha M. Sakya for the success of National Literacy and WASH Conference, Biratnagar.
 - Rtn. Ganesh R. Shrestha for 'Happy Landing' from Malaysia, fellowship at Kayastha family, and for appointment as a District TRF Fund-Raising Regional Chair (NRs. 500).
 - Rtn. Dr. Prakash R. Regmi for 'Happy Landing' from Bombay attending Cardiology Seminar (NRs. 500).
 - Rtn. Preeti Khemka for her selection to be a speaker as one of new members at the forthcoming District Conference in Birgunj (NRs. 500).
- 5. Other Contribution: Rtn. Kedar B. Shrestha donated a contribution of NRs.12,300 to the 'Fellowship Fund' of the RCP members. The funds were raised for the individualized mugs he presented to RCP members.
- 6. Rotary News/Information:

President Rtn. Chandralekha Kayastha reminded on information already shared: i. DTTS/AGs training seminar, ii. District Conference in Birgunj wherein there will be 12 participants from the RCP, iii. Planned Chepel trip with 5 members from the RCP, and iv. Selection of Rtn. Preeti Khemka as a new member speaker during the District Conference.

- 7. 2nd National Conference on Literacy and WASH in Schools, Biratnagar: Chair of the Conference PDG Rtn. Tirtha M. Sakya presented a 'Token of Appreciation' to President Rtn. Chandralekha Kayastha as one of host clubs of the conference. He also briefed on the successful conference with the participation of 360 registrants. The Conference had several achievements including the three MOUs to further Literacy and WASH in Schools, and to include TEACH achievements by the District Award Committee.
- 8. Cardiology Seminar, Bombay: Rtn. Dr. Prakash R. Regmi, who participated in this seminar briefed on important new developments. Famous teacher on Cardiology, US Doctor Valentin Fuster attended the seminar. Some of the evidence-based key developments explored during the seminar are captured below:
 - To cancel the 'borderline hypertension' category in blood pressure and consider it as 'hypertension, stage 1';

- Benefit of imaging to look at Femoral Artery for improved diagnosis of risk;
- Possible reduction (some 50%) of 'Genetics Risk' through behaviour change; and
- Improvement in Poly-Pill reduction of composition of Poly-Pill from four to three medicines for those who already have coronary heart disease.

Other information Rtn. Dr. Regmi shared was on mechanisms of 'Knowing Your Risk', move towards interventions instead of surgery, increasing use of the Atrial Fibrillations, and no evidence of benefit from the use of popular supplements.

- 9. Rotaract Rujen Shakya from the Rotaract Club of Patan presented the plans for organizing a Youth Leadership Camp of 2 days together with Rotaract Club of Metro Kathmandu. The objecting is the professional development of Rotaracts, and requested support and guidance for this from the Rotary Club of Patan.
