Minutes of Meeting No. 1914

Date: 28 Shrawan 2081 / 12 August 2024

- 1. President Rtn. Preeti Khemka called the RCP's Meeting No. 1914 to order with 15 seconds of 'Silent Invocation' for world peace, health, and happiness.
- 2. Guests welcomed by the President: AG Rtn. Suresh Acharya.
- 3. The last meeting minutes of the RCP were reviewed and adopted.
- 4. Happy News Contribution Pledges:

- Rtn. Rabendra R. Pandey confirmed transfer of Rs. 65,000 as pledged earlier Rs. 50,000 to KEEA and Rs. 15,000 for Vocational Awards (Plus an outstanding amount of Rs. 1,000 to the Sunshine Fund). He also handed handed over a cheque of Rs.50000 as his contribution to the Animal Welfare for Public Health Fund.

- 8. Before the adjournment of the meeting by the President, Secretary Rtn. Ganga R. Gautam announced: happy news contribution of Rs. 13,000 (50% of NRs. 6,500 each to the RCP's operational and sunshine funds), and the meeting attendance of 1 Rotarian AG, 28 members, and 8 make-ups.
