6. RCP's 5th Monday Entertainment Meeting with the visit of Nepal Youth Foundation, Olgapuri: On this occasion hosted by NYF, following the tour of the facilities at Olgapuri Village, President of NYF Rtn. Som Paneru made a power-point presentation to brief the RCP family and guests about NYF and its key activities in Nepal.

Founded by late Olga D. Murray in 1992, NYF, its major programmes are in the fields of Health & Nutrition, Children's Home (Residential Programme currently with about 80 children), Education programme, Vocational Education and Career Counselling (VECC), Ankur Counselling and Training Centre and Caste Equality Programme (CEP) for Dalit community in Saptari.

Rtn. Paneru elaborated on the programmes and ongoing activities providing more details on the Nutrition Rehabilitation Home in Kathmandu, and the Caste Equality Programme in the Terai region of Nepal. He also showed a brief video clip of the CEP demonstrating the actual living conditions of the 'Mushahar Basti' in Saptari where NYF is trying to make a difference in the lives of this deprived community.

The RCP has been collaborating with the NYF and have already partnered in several matching and global grant projects.

Following a Questions/Answers session, on behalf of all the participants, Rtn. Keshab B. Mathema gave a 'Vote of Thanks' to Rtn. Som Paneru, his spouse Sajani Paneru Amaya and the entire NYF Team for this excellent and very successful programme as an example of how social work could be done for the improvement of the lives of children/youth in Nepal. Rtn. Gabriele Mallapaty added that she had also visited the CEP in Saptari and appreciated the excellent work being done by NYF.

The RCP continued with a brief 5th Monday entertainment programme with contributions from Rtns. Maheswari Bisht Rawal, Rabendra R. Pandey, and Preeti Khemka. President Rtn. Preeti Khemka concluded the session with her own words of appreciation and thanks to all.

Between January-March 2025, the Media Relations team collaborated closely with Rotary members to enhance their messages, secure interviews, and develop content that appeared in national and regional media in more than 15 countries.
